September is Suicide Prevention Awareness Month National statistics list suicide as the second leading cause of death in adolescents ages 15-24.

Berry College is the recipient of the Campus Suicide Prevention grant through the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA). As a result of the grant, seventeen suicide prevention instructors completed the QPR (Question. Persuade. Refer.) Gatekeeper course to provide suicide prevention training at Berry. These instructors have facilitated training for most of the student leaders on campus. Due to these trainings over 100 students, faculty, and staff are now certified in Suicide Prevention through QPR.
